Application Instructions

The materials submitted with this application should be typed double spaced, minimum of size 12 font, and as concise as possible.

The application deadline for the current funding cycle is **April 30, 2010**. All applications must be sent by mail (no fax accepted) and postmarked no later than **April 30, 2010**. All material sent with the application will become the property of the Diocese of Lansing, Catholic Campaign for Human Development and will not be returned.

Description of CCHD Local Grants

Provides small grants to local organizations addressing poverty issues in our communities.

Applicants must provide program goals and objectives.

Criteria

1. The project must be governed by a 501(c)3, not-for-profit organization.
2. CCHD funds will not be granted to organizations that would utilize it to fund other organizations.
3. The organization for which funding is requested must conform to the moral teachings of the Catholic Church.
4. Clearly demonstrate how poverty will be impacted by the initiative.
5. Project must primarily benefit people within the geographic boundaries of the Diocese of Lansing or demonstrate solidarity with the poor in the United States.

Projects not meeting CCHD criteria

1. Projects controlled by government (federal, state, local), educational bodies, or political parties.
2. Research projects, surveys, planning and feasibility studies related to research, etc.
3. Individually owned, for-profit businesses.

Funding Priorities

1. Applicants connected to faith based community or community based organizations including a parish or organization belonging to the Catholic Diocese of Lansing.
