WHAT

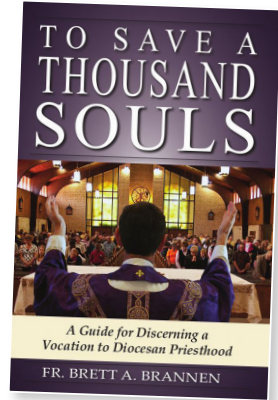
