WHAT

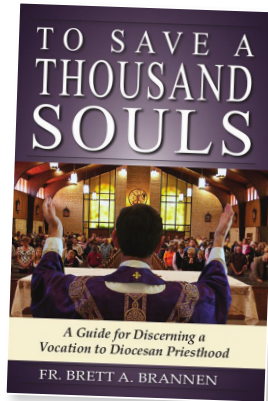
