n May 21, Bishop Boyea ordained 10 men to the permanent diaconate. The ordination Mass took place at St. Thomas Aquinas Parish in East Lansing. Permanent deacons are ordained ministers of the Catholic Church who are a sacramental sign to the Church and to the world of Christ, who came "to serve and not be served." Deacons serve the Church through their various ministries, which include proclaiming the Gospel, preaching, teaching, baptizing, leading the faithful in prayer, witnessing marriages and conducting wake and funeral services.


