WHAT

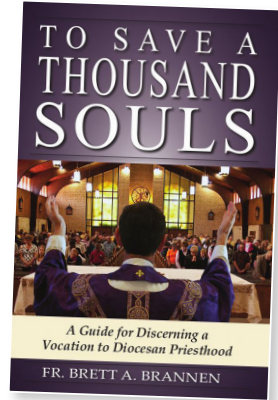

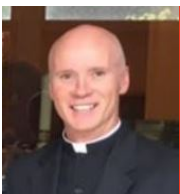
